The Quinte Woodland Conference is the resumption of 30 years of the Trenton Woodlot Conference. This year's 31st conference is on Thursday, October 2, 2025 at Maranatha Church, 100 College Street West in Belleville. This year's theme is *Tending our Woodlands:The Rewards of Action.*

Our new venue is a large, beautiful space with plenty of room for exhibits and vendor displays (see the attached photos). The large exhibitors' area is a central focus of the conference, so you can feature conservation initiatives in your communities, as well as your relevant products and services.
